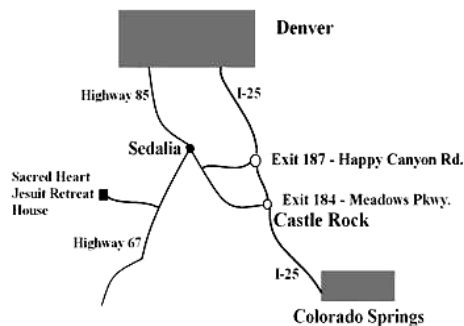

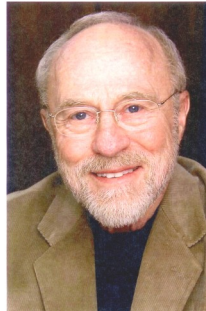


"Drawn Yet More Deeply"
