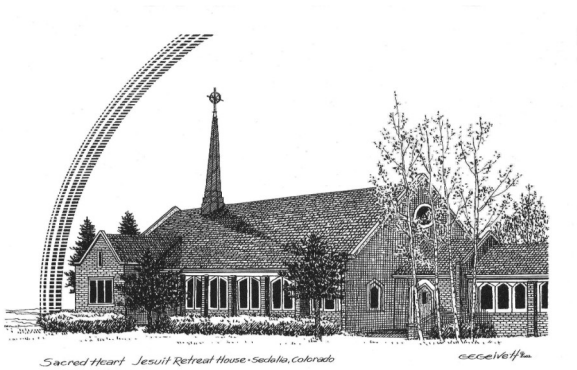

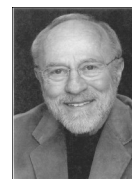
Fr. Gene Arthur, S.J. holds a doctorate in business administration from Indiana University and was a professor of management for 28 years at Rockhurst University. For many years he directed the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius Loyola in Daily Life for faculty and staff, and he has extensive experience in spiritual direction and in leading conference retreats.



Fr. Richard Dunphy, S.J. has been a retreat master and spiritual director at Sacred Heart Retreat House since 2002. After completing a doctorate in spirituality in 1983, he has served as faculty member, administrator, and chaplain at Jesuit universities in St. Louis, Rome, and Denver.



Sr. Eileen Currie, M.S.C. After spending twenty-four years in various levels of education, including serving as president of Cabrini College from 1982 to 1992, Eileen completed a master's degree in spirituality at Creighton University. She has extensive experience in spiritual direction and in giving conference retreats for groups.



Fr. Vince Hovley, S.J. holds a doctorate in mystical theology. His primary work has been spiritual direction and retreats. He also has lived and worked with the homeless of New York and Denver, taught theology, and directed a Jesuit leadership training program.



Fr. Ed Kinerk, S.J. was ordained in 1972. He received his doctorate in Spiritual Theology from the Gregorian University in Rome. His first assignment was to Sacred Heart Retreat House from 1975 to 1979. In subsequent years he has served as Novice Director, Provincial of the Missouri Province Jesuits, President of Rockhurst University, and currently as Administrator of Sacred Heart Retreat House.
